The Sispahlawts tribe originated on the upper Skeena, and their royal chief was Tkwawlawhae (now extinct). He came from Tsimshian, long before the arrival of the Neeswamak band of darkskies (Eagles). The Sispahlawts trace their beginnings back to dogs, and for this reason  $\Delta$
