1. txe'msəm, refers to wiget the Nass River culture hero and implies "lying person". A naxnɔq name. The performer would come among the guests and lie in the manner of wiget.
2. ma'a "yes" (in Hagwilgate), a naxnɔq name. The performer answered ma'a to every question.
3. ku'uwɔ'tu "lying person", a naxnɔq. The performer pretended to be hospitable, inviting many guests to his house, but when they came he ignored all but 2 or 3.
4. ga'kɪt "rat", a naxnɔq name. The performer, in a groundhog robe, ran about the house nibbling at the garments of the chiefs, in the manner of a rat.
5. pit'ye'tu "promising to go", a naxnɔq name.
