Ordinary speech is an attempt to say things that have clear
single meanings

Mythic " " " " use the other end of the one-
all dichotomy: to say things that mean every like thing.

- first is particularization

- second is generalization.

Myth is generalization

The problem of inventing writing as usually thought
to be "how to get enough meanings on" (predicates to
go with the subjects). Some attempted solutions may err in
the other direction: too much meaning (too many redundant
levels):- like the panel paper have too many levels...
Maybe some arts tell much more than intended to tell.

How to "add predicates" to a subject? 2 ways:

1. What is it doing? (holding cube)

2. What are its parts doing?

1. What is the explicit subject doing?

2. " are " implicit " a doing?
