- it is the special rights to land owned by original inhabitants vested in "
- we saw that
 - British in NA have always recognized these rights
 - Royal Proclamation 1763 turned them into law
 - Gov Douglas VI first recognized them, made treaties
 - Then VI & BC denied existence of native title
 - after Confederation, Canada shocked to realize not extinguished but failed to take steps to extinguish it.
 - Indians asserted their claim *Wesley Petition*
Claims of Alhed Tribes
 - 1926 Joint Senate House Committee rejected claim
said Indians had not established it
set up BC Special Grant, hoped it was finished
did collapse for a time
