- British in NA have always recognized these rights
- Royal Proclamation 1763 turned them into law
- Gov Douglas VI first recognized them, made treaties
- then VI + BC denied existence of native title
- after Confederation, Canada shocked to realize not extinguished
but failed to take steps to extinguish it.

- Indians asserted their claim ^{Native Title}
_{Claims of Alfred Tobies}

- 1926 Joint Senate House Committee rejected claim
said Indians had not established it
set up BC Special Grant, hoped it was finished
_{did collapse for a time}
