

Gitksan settlements

Wm Holland, 1920

1. gisg.a'g.əs

2. kispayaks "people of the hiding place"
 gitspa'x'ya'x (old pronunciation)
 Kulo now live here.

3. Glen Vowell. No Indian name. A new settlement established by Jockleson, a Salvation Army missionary. People are from Kigagas, Kiepeex, some from Kulo.

4. git'an'ma'ks "people fishing with torch" Hazelton

5. kitsegu'kla "people at the foot of the mountain" from big mountain behind: tsigu'kla

6. 'a'ndəm=ɔ:l git'andəm=ɔ:l people of fishing line
 ɔ:l is a string tied to a stick (delt) held in the hand
 with string between 3rd & 4th fingers, for catching fish
 It was an old fishing place, and Jockleson started a new settlement there

7. kitwəng.ε'

8. minskinict git|min|skini'ct
 people of by mountain

"people of the foot of sganict" a new settlement
 founded by Jockleson. Kitwanga and Kitwancool people

9. kitwintku'l

tku'ul small, or a narrow place. "people of the neck or narrows"
