p403 The word si'ñ x.i 'evening' was often used as a  
synonym for 'gruff'. siñ = day - lighter sky - dark =  
shenganagwa. p30

p26. Shening-Heavens (siñ) caused himself to be born from  
a cockle shell. He forked a dove - baby from Cockleshell  
Mother Carpenter assumed role of father


# Harada Lineage History

(a) Remembered moves, "real" traditional history

- i) 1730 Kargani migrations
- ii) 1730 West Coast migration
- iii) Rose Point → Hullon → Masset  
Rose Point → Cattlekingdom → Skidegate
- iv) In to and out of Masset Inlet
- v) Local moves at Kwayt, Moreby, Skidegate, Masset

} - same patterns, R & Eagle  
} - patterns which may be  
projected into past as  
real history.

(b) Postulated Hypothesized 5-row towns. "Story-towns"



(c) Origin refs and "grandmothers"

xagi "Foam Women"

atana

Rose Pt grandmother

Djilegona (Rankileth's wife)  
Property-Making-A-Noise  
Labret-Women

The mythologizing of history, putting history proper into stories (eg 5-row towns as in myth)  
a strain for consistency to make remembered history fit with mythology  
most notably, to create an original 5-row town where "all the Lavers"  
lived at the beginning.

Alternatively, where the common "grandmother" of them all lived (in a 5-row town)

Origins:

- 1) Cockle shell - floating achor R4  
- On Rose sp. - Ednahaw story - <sup>(makes eye out)</sup> Peacock story  
- Origin of Sun "Shining Heavens" - little bay
- 2) Ruf appears with "Grandmother" having many breasts

Raven eating eyes = Raven screwing kiowomen  
(gets him banished)

2 lines of thought:

- 1) Origin of eagle common grandmother (Kagi)
- 2) Original home of all the ravens (Egona)




## Harde Social Structure


