## CIASSROOM RULES - for children.

- 1. Be quiet at all times when coming in morning, afternoon and at recess periods. If not stay in 5 min . longer at noon, after school or at recess periods and sit perfectly still.
- 2. Do not leave the desk except to sharpen the pencil.
- 3. Do not talk.
- 4. Do not touch anything in the room except the books in your own desk.
- 5. Do not write on the boards.
- 6. Do not take anything without asking.
- 7. Do not play the piano.
- 8. Keep desks very tidy and have only your own book.s.
- 9. Do not mark a book or tear any paper out of the scribblers.
- 10. Each child has a drawing book of their own that they can write anything in.
  Other books are used when told by the teacher.
- 11. No books must be taken out of the desks when coming into the room.

## FOR TEACHER

- 1. Be patient .
- 2. Never let a child at tempt anything within their scope that they do not finish--even if the teacher has to help them with practically it all.
- 3. Exact implicit obedience but be jolly and the children willb.e.
- 4. Once in a while a child will lie or steal--if proven the strap is the punishment.
- 5. They will tell on each other-do not discourage altogether, but do not encourage. However, one cankeep tab on many little things that way.
- 6, They have been taught to take off their caps and not to interrupt.
