4. su-n̩'-sux "troublesome", a naxnq name.

\*When the name was assumed the members of this house would be very troublesome to all the assembled guests, jumping among them and purposely tripping them. Then the name was assumed from this.

5. x̩l̩'-ix "eating fur"(the wolf) The wolf eats the fur of its prey.
