Mercer 1916

Long ago he came from inland. Fought. Came to Upper Skeena and went down it (Flood reference)
spq at Hazelton is relative - same boys and women's names

sqatin came from Skeena long ago

mnesk

1927

sqatin was from gitzmaks, the same as spq
Because he was a chief at gitzmaks, and from
spq's house, he was recognized as a chief here.

1. gib'u' way name as spaq, gitamaks
on robe.

2. wu/nagaq laxe' "where opens the sky"
sun-like "hole" on robe red.

Also used as house name

3 smax - as a garment - doing antics of bear
climbing over the house

4 ma'tix mtngoat on pole - a duplicate
may be seen in cemetery at qitrat'in

1916

1. kibu highest crest, on poles, hats. It is the
tkwiftsatkum gib'u , a little different from
that of kst'ya'ox which is the grey wolf,
gwiaksmangib'u.

sqatinis is the highest. It is white wolf
mekskamgib'u , uses pearls

2. zo'l , the tkwiftsatkum smax prince of bears
pearl in eyes, ears, teeth. Only princes use pearl
head and body.

3. ma'tix t'sam'aks mtngoat of the water. Some
call it hagwol'sx TL, hats etc.

sqat'in

Men (including boys)

1. sqat'in "across salmon weir", naxnsg name.

In dramatizing the name, they built a weir across the house and fished out a "copper" of highest value.

This name formerly belonged to tsixg'an, a house now extinct, as a naxnsg. When that house became extinct, mug.ulks (former name of chieftain) took it into this house.

2. 'mu'g.ulks (former chief of this house)

"the wake" (where out from shore swims the beaver)

3. lu-dəldi'lpk"

lu-dəldi'lpkum q.a.g.a.g.a'ix kiyx
in short (pl) feathers of hawk (Taw)

4. qasq's.tk" (without) "equal" (the chieftain)

5. gamul/p "cover" (of the copper shield)

6. na'u'qx something to put a copper in

7. ti.la'qs axt, la'qst qeq Because of its
never bathes raven black colour

8. kwunba'tsk "towards lifted"

The chieftain is lifted from place to place

9. liyaxsi.gwz "to each side partaking" (the eagle)

10. ki.stamask" "on one side red"

11. q̥lax̥ta' yəsk

for q̥lax̥ta' x̥ske'msam sg. anis

along edge golden eagle mountain

The golden eagle flies along the edge of the mountain

12. x̥aini A name from the q̥tsang̥elam house
of txalaxtk, with whom they once intermarried.
Not really belongs here.

13. wɔ'sz̥lɔ:p "drying sticks, stones" (eagle)

The eagle uses stones as its drying sticks

14. uks̥aya wat 'out from shore shrubs' (the
eagle)

15 galge

16 wa'ce lɔ:p eating, sitting on a stone
