Memorials

6M-1, M-2. A pair of memorials representing Raven-fin (plate) a crest of "the west coast rear-town people" (R15d) which probably commemorated members of the owner's wife's family.

- 7. A house site owned by Sqaot, chief of the Masset-Inlet Gitans (E13a [aa]).
- 8. A house site only belonging to "the child" (NanEas) of "the Gitans of the west coast" (E20).

Memorials

In front of the last houses, towards the point are a number of mortuaries of several types.

AX. A unique double mortuary with a third post in the centre (plate) carved to represent the body of a bear. The front plaque, missing in the photographs, undoubtedly depicted the head of the bear.
